ORDER DIRECTING THE FILING OF A CORPORATE OWNERSHIP STATEMENT

Barring Congressional action, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure have been amended to: (1) require the debtor/corporation to file a corporation ownership statement; and (2) to require any corporation that is a party to an adversary proceeding, other than the debtor or a governmental unit, to file a corporate ownership statement. Accordingly, in the best interest of the administration of this Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the corporate ownership statement required to be filed by the debtor/corporation pursuant to Fed. R. Bank. P. 1007(a)(1) as amended, and by any corporation that is a party to an adversary proceeding, other than the debtor or a governmental unit, pursuant to new Fed. R. Bank. P. 7007.1, shall be filed on a form prescribed by the clerk.

This order is effective for all cases and adversary proceedings filed on or after **December 1, 2003.**
