**REVISED ORDER AMENDING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY
RULES 1007-1(e) and 7067-1(b)(1)**

Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007-1(e) specifies that the caption of the petition shall disclose all social security numbers used by the debtor(s) within the past 6 years. Local Bankruptcy Rule 7067-1(b)(1) specifies that an order for the withdrawal of funds held in an interest bearing account in the registry account shall state the name, addresses, and social security numbers of the recipients of the funds.

Barring Congressional action, an amendment to Fed. R.Bank. P. 1005 requires only the last four digits of the social security number on the caption of a petition commencing a case under the Code on or after December 1, 2003. The Court has determined that two local rules are affected by this amendment that limit the disclosure of a party's social security number, Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that L.B.R. 1007-1(e) (E.D.M.) is amended to state " The caption of the petition shall disclose the last four digits of all social security numbers and the full tax identification numbers used by the debtor(s) within the past 6 years." All other requirements of L.B.R. 1007(e) (E.D.M.) remain in effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that L.B.R. 7067-1(b)(1) (E.D.M.) is amended to state " An order for the withdrawal of funds held in an interest bearing account in the registry account shall state the names, addresses, and last four digits of the social security number or full employer identification numbers of the recipients of the funds." All other requirements of L.B.R. 7067-1(b)(1) (E.D.M.) remain in effect.

This order is effective for all cases filed and pending on or after **December 1, 2003.**
