**ORDER DIRECTING THE FILING OF PETITION PREPARER DISCLOSURE**

Barring Congressional action, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure have been amended to require a bankruptcy petition preparer to file a disclosure of compensation paid or promised. Accordingly, in the best interest of the administration of this Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the disclosure of compensation paid or promised to a bankruptcy petition preparer, required to be filed pursuant to new Fed. R. Bank. P. 2016(c), shall be filed on a form prescribed by the clerk.

This order is effective for all cases filed on or after **December 1, 2003**.
