ORDER DISMISSING CASE

On October 25, 2013, the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 7, a completed Schedule I and a completed Schedule J. Due to missing schedules and missing other documents, the Clerk of the Court filed a "Notice of Missing Documents" (the "Notice") on October 25, 2013 (Docket # 1). This Notice was mailed to the Debtor on October 27, 2013 by the Bankruptcy Noticing Center (*see* Docket # 11). The Notice informed the Debtor that certain schedules, statements and other documents were missing and had to be filed on or before November 8, 2013, or this case may be dismissed.

On November 8, 2013, the Debtor filed a completed Certificate of Budget and Credit Counseling, Schedule D, Schedule E, Schedule G and Schedule H. Also on November 8, 2013, the Debtor filed the following ***blank and incomplete*** documents: Chapter 7 Means Test, Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities, Statement of Financial Affairs; Summary of Schedules, Schedule A, Schedule B, Schedule C, and Schedule F. (Docket ## 15, 17). The Debtor did not file a completed Declaration Concerning Debtor's Schedules.

The Debtor did not comply with the requirements of the Notice. The blank and incomplete schedules, statements and documents filed by the Debtor are the functional equivalent of not filing the required documents under the Notice. The Debtor has not filed a motion to seek an extension of time of file the necessary schedules, statements, or other documents required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1007(b) as permitted by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1007(c). For these reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that this case is dismissed.
