**ORDER DISMISSING CASE,  
AND DIRECTING THE CLERK NOT TO ACCEPT FOR FILING ANY MORE  
BANKRUPTCY PETITIONS BY OR ON BEHALF OF, OR AGAINST, THIS DEBTOR,  
UNLESS THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THIS COURT HAS FIRST SIGNED AN ORDER  
GIVING DEBTOR PERMISSION TO FILE A NEW BANKRUPTCY CASE**

On February 26, 2008, Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 13, commencing Case No. 08-44378. On March 5, 2008, the Chapter 13 Trustee filed a motion to dismiss the case (Docket # 16 in Case No. 08-44378). On April 1, 2008, the Court entered an order granting the Trustee's motion to dismiss, which provided:

The debtor has now filed 13 bankruptcy cases. Upon the dismissal of this case and for the reasons stated on the record in open Court on March 26, 2008, it is hereby ordered that the debtor Vernon C. Taylor is barred and prohibited from filing any further bankruptcy cases unless he first obtains the permission of the Chief Bankruptcy Judge for good cause shown.

(Docket # 23 in Case No. 08-44378.)

There is nothing in the record of this case that demonstrates that the Debtor has obtained the permission of the Chief Bankruptcy Judge to file this bankruptcy case. Despite this, on November 15, 2013, Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 7, commencing this case. This bankruptcy case was therefore filed in violation of the bar to refiling another

bankruptcy case contained in the Court's April 1, 2008 Order in Case No. 08-44378.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, and under 11 U.S.C. § 105(a),

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. This bankruptcy case is dismissed.
2. The Clerk of this Court is directed not to accept for filing any further bankruptcy petitions by or on behalf of, or against, this Debtor, Vernon C. Taylor, unless and until the Chief Judge of this Court has signed an order granting Debtor permission to file a new bankruptcy case.

<sup>1</sup> This is not the first time that the Debtor has violated the April 1, 2008 bar order. Debtor filed Case No. 08-70066 on December 9, 2008, without first seeking or obtaining permission from the Chief Judge to do so. That case was dismissed.
