ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AMENDING ECF PROCEDURES 2(l) AND 7(b)

Presently, the Court's ECF Procedures 2(l) and 7(b) permit the submission of an order in either Word or WordPerfect format. The Administrative Office of the United States Courts has announced that it will no longer support enterprise licensing for WordPerfect beginning on October 1, 2019. As a result, beginning on that date, the Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan will only accept orders that are submitted in Word format. Therefore, the Court enters this administrative order to amend ECF Procedures 2(l) and 7(b) to eliminate the reference to the WordPerfect format. The Court will issue a notice to the bar of these amendments to the Court's ECF Procedures.

This order is effective October 1, 2019.
