

**NOTICE REGARDING CONDUCT OF HEARINGS BEFORE
JUDGE MARK A. RANDON EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY**

The following procedures will apply to hearings before Judge Randon effective immediately:

With the exception of trials, evidentiary hearings, and certain summary judgment motions, all hearings in cases pending before Judge Randon will be conducted by telephone. At least five minutes before the scheduled time for hearing, counsel and all interested parties should call 1-888-363-4734 and use Access Code 2795304. Landline connections are preferred, but cell phone or other telephone services are allowed. Counsel must place their phones on mute and wait until their case is called before unmuting their phones and placing their appearances on the record. Counsel and parties should keep their phones on mute when not speaking.

Trials and evidentiary hearings will be conducted in person unless a party requests that the Court conduct it by Webex. The party requesting the evidentiary hearing or trial by Webex must be prepared to indicate the reasons for doing so. Any stipulations to hold the trial or evidentiary hearing by Webex must also include the reasons. If the Court determines that a hearing on a summary judgment motion should be conducted in person, it will include that information in the notice of hearing.

All Chapter 13 status conferences with the Chapter 13 Trustee will continue to be conducted remotely until further notice. All contested Chapter 13 matters that are to be heard at 2:00 p.m. will also be conducted by telephone until further notice. Counsel and all interested parties must use the phone number and access code listed above for all contested matters.
