**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDING
LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES 1015-1(g) AND 3015-2(b)(1)(A)**

The Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure were amended on December 1, 2017. Two of the rules that were amended are Rules 1015 and 3015. The amendments made to those rules necessitate the Court making two amendments to the Local Bankruptcy Rules for the Eastern District of Michigan. Accordingly, to conform the Local Bankruptcy Rules for the Eastern District of Michigan to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, as amended on December 1, 2017,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local Bankruptcy Rule 1015-1(g) is amended to delete the words “husband and wife” and replace them with “spouses.”

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Local Bankruptcy Rule 3015-2(b)(1)(A) is amended to change the reference to Rule 3015 from subpart “(g)” to subpart “(h).”

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that redlined versions of Local Bankruptcy Rules 1015-1(g) and 3015-2(b)(1)(A), as amended by this order, are attached hereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendments made by this order are effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court shall conform the Local Bankruptcy Rules on the Court's website to the amendments made by this order.

Rule 1015-1(g)

(g) Joint Cases. Unless the court orders otherwise, the estates in a joint case filed by spouses a
husband and wife under § 302(a) will be jointly administered, but in such circumstances there is
no lead case for purposes of this rule.

Rule 3015-2(b)(1)(A)

(b) Post-Confirmation Plan Modification.

(1) The proponent of a post-confirmation plan modification must:

(A) serve the modification as required by F.R.Bankr.P. 3015(hg) and file a certificate of service;
