

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDING ORDER
REGARDING DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT REGISTRY FUNDS**

Local Bankruptcy Rule 7067-1 governs the deposit and withdrawal of funds in an interest bearing account in the registry of the Court. Under 28 U.S.C. § 2045, the Administrative Office of the United States Courts administers the Court Registry Investment System (“CRIS”) for the purpose of providing a safe, efficient market rate of return for registry funds. On February 7, 2013, this Court entered Administrative Order No. 13-02, which requires any funds on deposit with this Court to be deposited and administered in CRIS. The Court is entering this order to clarify that L.B.R. 7067-1 remains in full force and effect, except to the extent that it is expressly modified by Administrative Order No. 13-02.
