**ORDER GRANTING THE MOTION OF THE DEBTORS
TO VOLUNTARILY DISMISS THIS CHAPTER 13 CASE,
AND DENYING THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO CONVERT**

This Chapter 13 case is before the Court on the motion filed by the Debtors on September 14, 2020, seeking the voluntary dismissal of this case (Docket # 75, the "Motion"). The United States Trustee filed an objection to the Motion, also on September 14, 2020, as well as a motion to convert this case to Chapter 7 (Docket ## 76, 77).

The Court concludes that a hearing is not necessary, and that this case must be dismissed. This is a Chapter 13 case. Under 11 U.S.C. § 1307(b), the Debtors have an absolute right to voluntarily dismiss this case. *See, e.g., In re Fulayter*, 615 B.R. 808, 815-22 (Bankr. E.D. Mich. 2020). This is so even under the extraordinary circumstances alleged in this case by the United States Trustee.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is granted, and this case is dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to convert filed by the United States Trustee (Docket # 77) is denied, as moot.
