

# TRANSMISSION OF THE 341(a) NOTICE/ EMAIL ENHANCEMENTS

## **Email Enhancements**

*BNC Certificate of Notice:* The notice will now include all entities selected as form recipients and all recipients who received a "Notice of Electronic Filing" through CM/ECF, along with the date of electronic notification and the entity's name and email address.

*Email Bypass Notice to Debtor's Attorney:* The BNC bypasses notices determined to be undeliverable by the U.S. Postal Service. Previously the BNC would mail a paper notice to the debtor's attorney that an intended recipient was bypassed. Now the BNC will transmit the bypass notice to the attorney's primary email address. No paper bypass notice will be mailed.

*Transmission of the Notice of Commencement: Delivery of Section 341(a) Notice to Debtor's Attorney:* Previously the BNC mailed a paper 341(a) notice (Notice of Commencement) with the debtor's full social security number (SSN) to the debtor's attorney. The attorney will no longer receive a paper copy of the Notice of Commencement, instead, the registered attorney will receive a secure link via email and will be provided one "free look" of the notice containing the full SSN. If more than one case is filed in a day, the BNC will send a summary email with multiple links.
