



INDIVIDUAL PACER ACCOUNTS REQUIRED FOR FILING – SECOND NOTICE

The United States Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of Michigan will be going live with CM/ECF Next Generation on **June 1, 2021**. On that date, CM/ECF users or filers will no longer be able to log in to their CM/ECF accounts as they currently do. Instead, users or filers will log in to CM/ECF through a Central Sign-On (PACER) to file documents.

1) USERS AND FILERS WILL NEED TO OBTAIN THEIR OWN INDIVIDUAL PACER ACCOUNTS.

To obtain a new PACER account or upgrade an existing PACER account, please visit www.pacer.gov. Shared PACER accounts will not be able to be used once the court has upgraded.

2) USERS AND FILERS WILL NEED TO KNOW THEIR CURRENT CM/ECF LOGIN AND PASSWORDS.

3) LINKING PACER ACCOUNT TO CM/ECF ACCOUNT

On or after June 1, 2021 you must link your upgraded PACER account to your CM/ECF account e-file.
