**NOTICE REGARDING DEBTOR'S CONVERSION
OF CASE FROM CHAPTER 7 TO CHAPTER 11 OR 13**

The conversion of a case under 11 U.S.C. §706(a) requires the filing of a motion to convert under F.R.Bank.P. 1017(f)(2). Parties are entitled to 20 days' notice of the motion under F.R.Bank.P. 2002(a)(4).

Therefore, a conversion by the debtor under 11 U.S.C. §706(a) shall be on motion with a 20 day notice and opportunity to respond under Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1. An order of conversion will be entered under the procedures of that rule.
