ORDER Rescinding COVID-19 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

After consideration of public and federal health guidelines to determine appropriate protocols for conducting proceedings in the courthouses,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following administrative orders (COVID-19 Emergency Orders) are rescinded immediately:

- 2020-04 Order Regarding Continued Bankruptcy Court Operations During the Exigent Circumstances Caused by COVID-19,
- 2020-06 Order Extending COVID-19 Emergency Procedures,
- 2021-19 Order Establishing a Drop Box in the Detroit Courthouse and Extending COVID-19 Emergency Procedures.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall immediately post to the Court's external website and circulate to all Listserv recipients a notice announcing that the COVID-19 Emergency Orders have been rescinded and the lobby and intake areas at all court locations are open to all members of the public effective April 11, 2022.

Each judge will continue to decide and communicate how court proceedings in matters assigned to that judge will occur, whether by telephone, by video, in person, or a combination of methods.
