The monthly financial reports of a debtor in possession in a chapter 11 case would normally be filed in paper because the debtor in possession is not an entity that may register as an ECF Filer pursuant to the Court's Administrative Procedures for Electronic Case Filing.

For the same reason, documents filed by a noticing agent or a claims agent in a chapter 11 case would normally be filed in paper.

These documents may be voluminous and therefore burdensome for the Clerk's Office staff to scan in the Court's electronic records system.

Accordingly, it is ordered that the monthly financial reports of a debtor in possession and all documents to be filed by a noticing agent or a claims agent shall be filed electronically by the attorney for the debtor, based on the attorney's mandatory ECF date pursuant to Administrative Order 05-04.
