At the close of business on Thursday, May 26, 2005, the court will begin the process of converting it's electronic database from BANCAP to CM/ECF (Case Management/Electronic Case Filing), a new system designed to allow for the filing of papers by electronic means. IT IS ORDERED that the Court and Clerk's Offices be closed on Friday, May 27, 2005.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event May 27, 2005, was the last day of a designated period to file a pleading or other paper, the time to timely file such pleading or other paper is extended to May 31, 2005, in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a).
