As soon as reasonably practicable after 5:00 p.m. on the date of entry of this Administrative Order, the Clerk will reassign to Judge Gretchko all Detroit Chapter 13 cases and all adversary proceedings filed in such cases, that are currently pending as designated "Successor to Judge Shefferly."
- 2. As soon as reasonably practicable after 5:00 p.m. on the date of entry of this Administrative Order, using the Court's blind draw system, the Clerk will assign all Detroit Chapter 13 cases to Judge Tucker, Judge Randon, Judge Oxholm, and Judge Gretchko.
