Notice Regarding Bankruptcy Forms B22A-1, Chapter 7 Statement of Your Current Monthly Income; B22A-1 SUPP, Statement of Exemption from Presumption of Abuse Under § 707 (b)(2); and B22A-2 Chapter 7 Means Test Calculation and associated ECF events effective December 1, 2014

On November 19, 2014, the Office of the Clerk posted a notice regarding changes to the Bankruptcy Rules, Official Forms, Fees, and ECF Events that went into effect December 1, 2014. Nine official forms have been revised and are identified in the November 19, 2014 notice. This notice provides additional information for the use of three of the nine revised forms. Failure to file the correct official form will result in an order directing the filing of official forms. If the amended document is not filed timely, the original document may be stricken or the case may be dismissed without a hearing.

The November 19, 2014 notice stated, in part, that the old B22A form commonly known as the Chapter 7 Means Test had been split into two forms; the Chapter 7 Statement of Your Currently Monthly Income (B22A-1) and the Chapter 7 Means Test Calculation (B22A-2). It is important that these forms are filed using the correct ECF event as outlined in the chart below. If the correct ECF event is not used, the pleading may be stricken.

Exemptions from means testing have been placed in a separate supplement entitled Statement of Exemption from Presumption of Abuse Under § 707(b)(2) (B22A-1 SUPP). This form may be filed with the Chapter 7 Statement of Your Current Monthly Income.
