NOTICE REGARDING CASH PAYMENTS IN THE BAY CITY OFFICE

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2026

Effective May 1, 2026, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, Bay City location will no longer accept cash payments.

Registered CM/ECF users must continue to submit payment of court filing fees directly in CM/ECF when filing a document with the Court or use the online payment program as appropriate. If paying by mail or in person, acceptable forms of payment include corporate checks, cashier's or certified checks, and money orders made payable to the "Clerk, United States Bankruptcy Court".

Debtors can pay fees [on-line](#) using a debit card, PayPal, or ACH. If paying by mail or in person, acceptable forms of payment include cashier's or certified checks, and money orders made payable to the "Clerk, United States Bankruptcy Court". The Clerk's Office does not accept personal checks, or credit cards from debtors.

Please note that a fee is charged for any failed payments, including those resulting from the entry of incorrect routing or account numbers, or insufficient funds available.
