

**UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT EASTERN DISTRICT
OF MICHIGAN NOTICE REGARDING PLEADINGS USING
GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE**

The use of generative artificial intelligence to draft pleadings and documents filed with the Court has increased over the years. While this technology is useful, counsel and parties are reminded that they have an independent duty and obligation to verify the accuracy of pleadings and documents prior to the filing with this Court.

In particular, Rule 9011 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure applies to all documents filed with the Court, and the Court construes all filings as a certification by the person signing the filed document of compliance with Rule 9011(b). A violation of Rule 9011 could cause the imposition of a sanction including a non-monetary directive, an order to pay a penalty to the Court, or an order directing payment of reasonable attorney fees and other expenses directly resulting from the violation.
