**NOTICE REGARDING THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE PROGRAM'S  
NEW CHAPTER 11 PERIODIC REPORTS (28 C.F.R. § 58.8)**

Please take notice, that on December 21, 2020, the U.S. Trustee Program (USTP) promulgated a final rule, "Procedures for Completing Uniform Periodic Reports in Non-Small Business Cases Filed Under Chapter 11 of Title 11" (hereinafter referred to as the "Final Rule") to take effect on June 21, 2021. The Final Rule, which is authorized by 28 U.S.C. § 589b, requires that chapter 11 debtors in possession and trustees (other than small business debtors) file monthly operating reports (MORs) and post-confirmation reports (PCRs). <https://www.justice.gov/ust/chapter-11-operating-reports>. These new forms must be used for all report filings on or after June 21, 2021.
