A. AMENDMENTS TO FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE

Amendments to the following Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure ("Bankruptcy Rules") are effective December 1, 2016: 1010, 1011, 2002, 3002.1, 7008, 7012, 7016, 9006, 9027, and 9033. In addition, **new** Bankruptcy Rule 1012 is effective on December 1, 2016.

Please note that the amendment to Rule 9006 is particularly important in that the change reduces the current computation for papers served electronically. Attorneys filing papers in the Eastern District of Michigan must indicate in the certificate of no response if all parties are served electronically.
