**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC REGARDING OPERATING STATUS
OF THE U.S. BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE EASTERN
DISTRICT OF MICHIGAN**

Pursuant to the direction of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of Michigan will continue operations for an estimated 10 business days despite the federal government shutdown effective on October 1, 2013. Court business will be conducted as usual. All proceedings and deadlines remain in effect as scheduled, unless otherwise advised. The Case Management and Electronic Files (CM/ECF) system will remain in operation for the electronic filing of documents with the court. The intake department will be open for filing of paper pleadings and court staff will be also be available to answer questions or assist the public by phone.

If the government shutdown continues past the 10 days (on or around October 15, 2013), the court will issue a notice with updated operating status information.
